If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

Cite every chapter of the book that you write. Doing so will also give the real authors the credit they deserve. Even if you plan on paraphrasing certain content, you'll be required to provide a citation for the ideas you referenced. A chapter in an authored ebook from an academic collection should be treated as a chapter in an authored print book with the reference ending with the publisher. For a chapter in an authored print book or ebook with a DOI, see Chapter in an Authored Book with a DOI.

If there are different authors for each chapter, you need to reference EACH chapter you use. If you use multiple chapters from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you use. (This is because you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book).

APA Format Broken Down: Use this format if you are using 1 chapter out of a book that has many chapters, and each chapter is written by a different author. If each chapter is written by the same author, just cite the entire book. Parts of the APA Citation Explanation Author's Last name, First initial.

How To Cite a Chapter From a Book in APA Format

Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

How to Cite a Book in APA Style | Formats & Examples

To begin, immediately following a quotation or a paraphrase, APA citation style requires an in-text citation. Typically, these in-text references include the author's last name, followed by a comma and the year. You do not need to include the title of the chapter for most in-text citations.
